THIBODAUX – Lafourche Parish District Attorney Camille A. Morvant, II has been appointed to the membership of the Louisiana State Law Institute.

The Louisiana State Law Institute, organized under authority of the LSU Board of Supervisors, was chartered, created and organized as an official advisory law revision commission, law reform agency and legal research agency of the State of Louisiana.

Founded on the LSU campus in 1933, the Institute draws its membership from the state and federal judiciary, including the Louisiana Supreme Court, the offices of the Governor and Attorney General, the legislature, law school administrators and various bar associations and the public defender’s association. Morvant is the District Attorney appointed to represent the Louisiana District Attorney’s Association.

The general purposes of the Louisiana State Law Institute are to promote and encourage the clarification and simplification of the law of Louisiana and its better adaptation to present social needs, to secure the better administration of justice, and to carry on scholarly legal research and scientific legal work.
