THIBODAUX – Christie Pepper, an investigator with the Lafourche Parish District Attorney's Office, was elected as the President of the Louisiana District Attorneys' Association Investigators Board on July 8.

"We are tremendously proud of Christie," said District Attorney Cam Morvant. "She has been an outstanding investigator for us, so I'm not surprised that she's now being recognized by her peers. She is very worthy of this honor."

Pepper was elected at the 40th Annual LDAA conference held in Destin, Florida. She will serve as president for a one-year term. Pepper has been employed by the Lafourche Parish Sheriff's Office for thirteen years, having been assigned to the Lafourche Parish DA's Office for the last eight. She has a degree in criminal justice from Nicholls State University, and during her career has worked in law enforcement communications, probation, and in the court system. She is certified through the FBI POST academy instructor course to teach POST academy courses.
